Changes to managing Seniors membership.

The Committee has moved Seniors membership records to Action Network - the database which the national party uses for communicating with Party members.

The Google Group allows members to communicate with one another. We know that some members enjoy the conversations but also that others find the number of emails overwhelming.

Now that we have separated the two features, if you don't want to take part in conversations you can unsubscribe from Google Group emails, or from the Google Group entirely - but you will still be a member of Green Party Seniors.

Seniors Committee meeting - March

Marcus Grant, a member of the Health and Wellbeing Policy Working Group, gave us a presentation on the work of the group, which is undertaking a complete policy rewrite.

The new policy will emphasise the creation and maintenance of good health and wellbeing. The NHS - which the Green Party will always support - should not be expected to cure illnesses which could have been avoided.
